ACADEMIC STANDARDS & CREDIT

NEW: Government and Citizenship 120B.024 subd. 1

The social studies graduation requirement, which is 3.5 credits and <u>must</u> include a government and citizenship graduation credit, now has an implementation date of the **2025-26 school year**.

- This applies to students who are in ninth grade, during the 2025-26 school year
- Advanced coursework which includes government and citizenship can satisfy these requirements

NEW: World's Best Workforce Definition 120B.10 and 120B.11

The Worlds Best Workforce title to Minnesota's accountability system was <u>changed</u> to "Comprehensive Achievement and Civic Readiness." It also adds to the current list of purposes of the education system, by adding that the system "prepare students to become lifelong learners."

NEW: Health Standards 120B.021 subd. 1

Schools must continue to use locally developed academic standards in health until statewide rules implementing uniform statewide health standards occur.

One credit of health, using locally developed academic standards, remains a graduation requirement until statewide health standards are implemented.
